What will I be assessed on?	In Sports Studies, you have already been externally assessed in RO51 Contemporary Issues and RO53 Leadership. To complete your assessment, students will use their written coursework for the following units: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Finish RO52 Developing Sports Skills unit by completing the LO4 assignment- Evaluation of Netball Performance• Complete an examination board past paper in exam conditions.
How will I be assessed over the coming weeks and months?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Completion of assignments using examination board produced assignment briefs• All assignments and exam papers will be marked using examination board mark schemes for assignments
When will the assessments take place?	Completion of assignments will take place during normal lesson times and coursework sessions after school. Coursework will be marked and verified by the PE staff. Completion of exam assessment will take place during lesson time in exam conditions and marked using examination board mark scheme.
What evidence will be used to create my portfolio?	You will have 3 sources of evidence: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. RO53 Your leadership assignments and, where available, externally moderated grade.2. RO51 Your contemporary issues exam results from Jan 2021(or mock exam result)3. RO52 Your teacher produced witness statements for practical sports and LO4 Written assignment produced by you. Teachers will work with individual students to ensure that portfolio includes your best work that demonstrates your performance.
What happens with my NEA?	Your NEA is your coursework. Most of the course is based on this format of assessment and many students produce their best work this way. Much of this work is already completed.
What can I do to prepare?	Continue to attend Sports Studies lessons on time. Revise RO51 unit if you are re-sitting the exam. Attend coursework catch up sessions after school where possible. Apply maximum effort in lessons and act upon feedback given.
