Keywords:

Anoint	To rub with oil, typically as part of a religious ceremony to set someone apart
Covenant	An agreement with God
Descendant	A person who comes from someone else
Doom	Death, destruction, or some other terrible fate
Engrave	To cut or carve (a text or design) on the surface of a hard object
Faith	To have complete trust or confidence in someone or something.
Idol	An image or representation of a god used as an object of worship.

Key Knowledge:

What is a Covenant?

A covenant is an agreement with God, the Old Testament is about how God wanted to make a covenant with us. He set out the terms and conditions of his covenant to a few specially chosen people including Noah, Abraham, Moses, David ect

Noah

Noah was an obedient servant of God who became favoured by God as he was faithful amongst many sinners. Noah built an Ark that saved himself and his family as well as every land animal from a great flood that God unleashed in judgement on earth.

Abraham

Abraham is regarded as the first leader of the Jewish people. In Genesis Chapter 12 God asks Abraham to leave his home and promises 3 things:

1. A relationship with God
2. Numerous descendants
3. Land. God tested Abraham's obedience in Genesis Chapter 22 when he asked him to sacrifice his son Isaac.

Moses

Moses was born a Jewish slave, rescued and brought up by Pharaoh's daughter. He first heard God in a burning bush, later in life God calls Moses to receive the 10 Commandments and he also helps the Jewish people flee Egypt where God caused 10 plagues so Pharaoh would let the Jews go. On escape Moses parted the Red Sea and Pharaoh's army drowned.

David

David was a shepherd who became a warrior and defeated Goliath despite everybody thinking he was too small and weak, he was later anointed the King.

Jesus

Jesus was a prophet as he used God's power to perform miracles, he heard and spoke God's words. He called people's faithfulness to God and was also persecuted and rejected.
