Owing to this, and in order to develop our Remote Learning offer further, we will be hosting a 'live lesson' in Maths, English and Science for Year 9 students who have been identified as needing to isolate. This will be delivered through Microsoft Teams by a subject specialist.

The below timetable details the date, time and location for the live lesson. Due to new contact tracing measures, your child may not take part in the lesson with the same teacher or students that they normally do. Lessons will be delivered in the Year 9 Team channel, therefore, please advise your child to check the channel prior to the lesson to ensure they are successfully able to access it.

To ensure your child can successfully log into Microsoft Teams, we have created two 'how to' videos on YouTube to talk them through the process on a computer and a smart phone (see links below). Alternatively, they can email itsupport@stannesrchighschool.com for further guidance. Registers will be taken during these lessons and non-attendance will be reported to the Pastoral and Attendance Teams. If your child is unable to access the Live Lesson at the specified time, a recording of the lesson will remain accessible in that Team.
