### Key Knowledge:

#### Pentecost:

All the believers were gathered together in one place. Suddenly there was a noise from the sky which sounded like a strong wind blowing, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. Tongues of fire which spread out and touched each person there.<sup>4</sup> They were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to talk in other languages. Jews living in Jerusalem and religious people had come from every country in the world. They were all excited because all of them heard the believers talking in their own languages. The believers were talking like Galileans and yet they could still be understood by people from other countries. Some people made fun of the believers, saying, "These people are drunk! Peter stood up with the other eleven apostles and in a loud voice began to speak to the crowd: Fellow Jews and all of you who live in Jerusalem, listen to me and let me tell you what this means.<sup>15</sup> These people are not drunk, as you suppose; it is only nine o'clock in the morning.

#### The Holy Spirit in the Old Testament and New Testament:

The Old Testament mentions the Holy Spirit 88 times. 23 books in the Old Testament refer to the Holy Spirit. Although the actual expression "Holy Spirit" is used only 3 times. The New Testament mentions the Holy Spirit 264 times

#### The Fruits of the Holy Spirit:

Galatians 5:22-25

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. There is no law against these things. Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit.

#### The Gifts of the Holy Spirit:

GIFTS	Definition
WISDOM	Making a good decision based on your past experiences. Being wise.
UNDERSTANDING	Being intelligent about other people. Understanding why things happen.
KNOWLEDGE	What is known about a particular subject such as facts and information.
COURAGE	Strength in the face of pain. Doing something when scared.
RIGHT JUDGEMENT	Choosing to do the right thing by considering our conscience.
REVERENCE	Respect of God.
WONDER AND AWE	Amazement at the power and beauty of God and the World.

#### Ascension:

Then they gathered around him and asked him, "Lord, are you at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel?"<sup>7</sup> He said to them: "It is not for you to know the times or dates the Father has set by his own authority. <sup>8</sup> But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you <sup>9</sup> After he said this, he was taken up before their very eyes, and a cloud hid him from their sight. **Will** be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."<sup>10</sup> They were looking intently up into the sky as he was going, when suddenly two men dressed in white stood beside them.<sup>11</sup> "Men of Galilee," they said, "why do you stand here looking into the sky?
